Rebuilding Together Community Impact in Albany, Berkeley, Emeryville

In 2005

- 22 homes repaired
- 10 community facilities repaired
- 1,600 volunteers
- \$500,000 worth of renovations completed
- Repaired homes for 9 hurricane evacuee families

Since 1991

- 398 homes repaired
- 116 community facilities repaired
- 17,350 volunteers
- More than \$5 million worth of renovations

The Need for Rebuilding Together

In Alameda County, 46% of single seniors and 33% of elderly couples live on incomes at or below the poverty level. Rebuilding Together ABE provides a critically needed service, as demonstrated by the overwhelming number of applications received for home repair work.

Rebuilding Together's large network of volunteers can rapidly respond to emergencies, as evidenced by the housing that was repaired for nine hurricane evacuee families.

Rebuilding Together is adding earthquake damage prevention teams to the existing energy, safety, and green teams that assess and work on each home.

Sponsors, a team of volunteers, and plenty of community spirit transform a house for an elderly homeowner.

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2006 Sponsor Guidelines

Sponsors are essential partners in the Rebuilding Together home repair process. Sponsors provide the financial support and volunteer commitment necessary to make this community program a success.

Sponsors' Role:

Make a contribution of at least \$4,000.

If possible, provide:

1. a volunteer team of 20-30 people;
2. a skilled House Captain (Project Manager) to plan the scope of work and supervise the workday;
3. a First Mate (Volunteer Coordinator) to coordinate the team and serve as a homeowner liaison;
4. skilled carpenters, electricians, plumbers, painters, cement masons, etc.

Rebuilding Together's Role:

1. Select appropriate homeowners, home repair sites, and community facilities.
2. As needed, meet with sponsors, review the program, make presentations to volunteers.
3. Provide training, program manuals and materials to House Captains & First Mates.
4. Provide help in recruiting skilled labor to accomplish the repairs.
5. Order all standard materials and supplies and have available for pickup at our warehouse.
6. Acknowledge sponsors and contributors in our annual newsletter.
7. Provide a banner for each house recognizing Sponsors.
8. Provide each volunteer with a Rebuilding Together event t-shirt.
9. Provide a recognition dinner for sponsors and key volunteers in May.
10. Provide other benefits according to Sponsor level.
